# **ArborTags**



The needles, bunched in pairs, grow very densely on the branchlets. They are sharply pointed and stiff, 3-5 inches long with 12-14 lines of stomata on each side. You will find 2 needles in a bundle.

The cones are 2-3 inches long and half as wide before opening. The scales can be an inch long with a keel or ridge down the center, often ending with a prickle.
