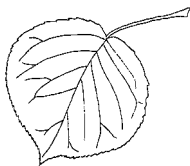

An early bloomer, the small white flowers are borne in numerous clusters turning the tree entirely white. The fruit is a small round pear growing in clusters at the end of stocky branches.

Often a dense conical shape with a multitude of vertical sprouts. The dense wood and heavy branching leads to a weak structure, the loss of major branches, and topping in high winds. Older trees have often lost their regular shape.
