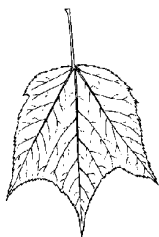


ArborTags

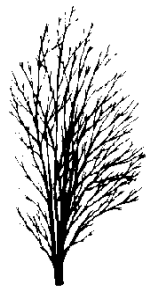
